

Dear Parents,

Welcome to third grade! I will be your child's teacher and I am excited about starting a new school year. I look forward to building a partnership between home and school. There is a lot to discuss, but I have tried to cover some of the important questions and concerns you may have.

-Children should go onto the playground when they arrive at school. They can put their belongings in our line (B-1) and play until the bell rings. They should NOT come through the halls unless the bell has already rang.

-Make sure your child knows how they are getting home each day. They need to know their bus number or who and where their ride is.

-Breakfast is \$1.75, lunch is \$2.50, and milk is 75 cents.

-If your child can bring one box of mechanical pencils, one box of regular pencils, one bottle of glue, one package of glue sticks, two packages of "Expo" dry erase markers, and one box of Kleenex the first week of school, it would be greatly appreciated.

-I am asking for \$15 from each student. The money goes toward agendas (\$5.00), art/craft supplies, science materials, rewards, and field trips. Cash is fine or you can make a check out to SWE.

-If your child has allergies, medical conditions, or if there is anything you feel I need be aware of, please let me know.

-Please mark your calendar for Tuesday, August 2nd at 6:30 p.m. for parent night. Parent night will give us a chance to sit down and discuss curriculum, homework policy, discipline, expectations, etc. More information about parent night will be sent out later this week.
